BUDDHA WOOD OIL

Eromophila mitchelli

Tenacious, unique, and sweet. *Eromophila mitchelli*, also known as Buddhawood is a small figwort tree found in the Australian desert. The scented wood is traditionally burned for its pleasant aroma, and has been used by indigenous Australians for its antibacterial qualities.

Buddha Wood is steam distilled to extract a smokey, resinous aroma that beautifully complements any fresh base note.

Buddha Wood Oil is comprised of ketones, eremophilone and santalcamphor. Containing similar constituents to Agarwood, Buddha Wood Oil is composed of eremophilone, 2-hydroxyeremophilone, and 2-hydroxy-2-dihydro eremophilone.



CHARACTERISTICS

Buddha Wood Oil is a dark copper red oil. Opaque, viscous, with a medium intensity aroma - the scent can be described as smoked and earthy, with a sustained, spicy undertone.

USAGE

Buddha Wood Oil can be used as a fragrance in skincare formulations, perfumes, in essential oils and aromatherapy.

COMPLEMENTS

Buddha Wood Oil can be used as a base note fragrance, and beautifully complements cedarwood, sandalwood, peru balsam, rose, lavender, and ylang ylang.
